Access denied is caused by one of two things; either your password has expired or you are locked out of your account.

Checking for Expired Password

If you get this message (see Figure 1).

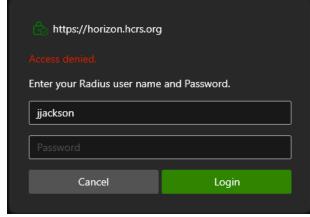

Go to the regular HCRS website (https://www.hcrs.org/). In the top right corner of the website you will see Staff/Board Login (see **Figure 2**).

You will be presented with a login screen (see **Figure 3**). Enter in your full HCRS email address. Click Next, then enter in your HCRS password (one for Horizon/signing on to a desktop).

You will then be presented with this screen (see **Figure 4**) click on "Verify my identify".

You will then be prompted to authenticate using Duo.

Once verified you will be presented with the screen shown in **Figure 5**. Click on "Reset my password".

You will then be asked for your current password (the one you just used) and then the new password you are establishing.

Click on Save. If successful you will be presented with a screen saying "Reset successful". You can now use this password to get into Horizon.

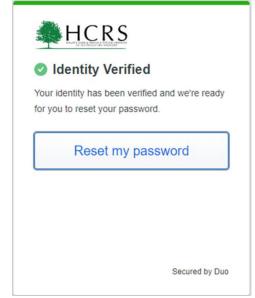
